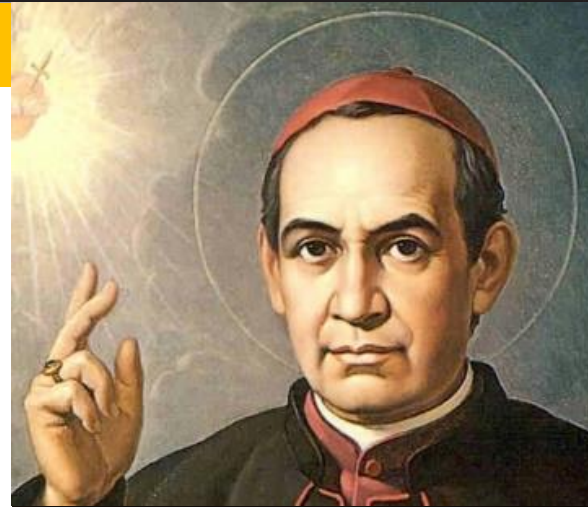
Weekly Letter from the Principal

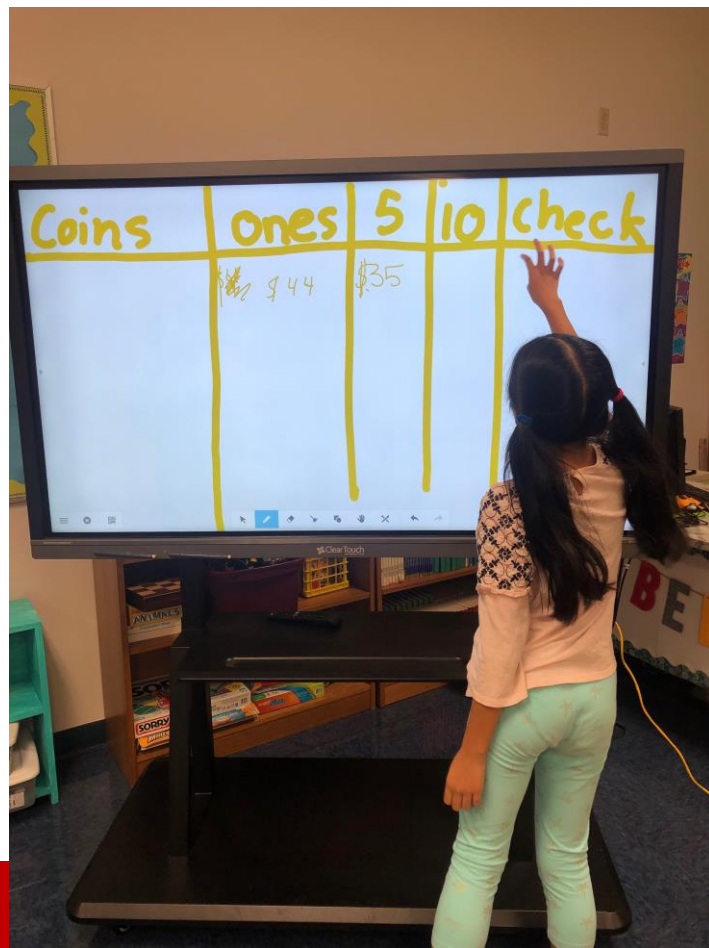
